



Electronic Results Transfer via the Internet using eClinic software.

The Victorian Cytology Service has been offering electronic downloading of results via dial-up modem for a few years. As an alternative, it is now possible to download VCS results via the Internet using eClinic's Secure Medical Services (SMS) client software.

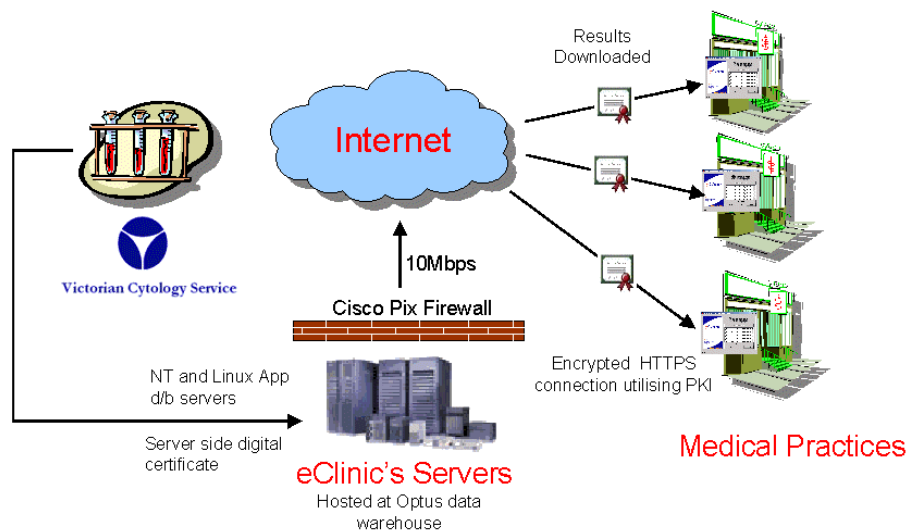
eClinic fully automates the transfer of cytology results, securely and conveniently, directly from VCS to your clinic. To access test results, doctors may elect to download directly into their patient management systems utilising the SMS client, or view and print results from eClinic's result viewer.

How it works

The eClinic SMS client software utilises Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) with site based eSign digital certificates and fully encrypted SSL (Secure Socket Layer) data transfer. This ensures highly secure communication, authentication and data integrity for the transmission of cytology results directly into the patient management software. Compatible software packages include Medical Director, Medical Spectrum, MedTech, Genie and most other practice management software. The SMS client software is easy to install and compatible with most Windows operating systems (Macintosh compatibility will be available soon).

eClinic's Infrastructure

eClinic's result delivery infrastructure is secure, scalable and reliable



Potential benefits for the medical practice:

- Results will generally be available for download within one hour of reporting.
- Elimination of the need for dial-up modems and phone lines.
- Immediate availability for many existing eClinic users (no installation required).
- The eClinic SMS client software features an auto download scheduler allowing practices to set times for automatic retrieval of results.
- Results may be downloaded manually at any time.
- SMS Result Viewer allows direct access to results without practice management software.
- The eClinic Internet result service is provided free to VCS clients (practices are responsible for their own Internet connection).
